Class A – Veterinary Science

No more than **3** exhibits per member. Poster size to be 14" x 22". Attach entry tag to upper right corner. Exhibit must be brought to the Animal Science Department in Youth Exhibit Building B on entry day. Judging will take place Thursday. Premiums: \$1.75 - \$1.50 - \$1.25 - \$1

Class B – Pets

1. No more than **2** pet exhibits per member plus **1** educational display.

2. Supply your own cages. Be sure cage is secure.

3. Cavy exhibitors must put name of breed on entry tag. Cavy age descriptions:

Junior – up to 4 months, no more than 22 ounces in weight

Intermediate – 4-6 months, 22-30 ounces in weight

Senior – over 6 months, over 30 ounces in weight

4. Ferrets must be vaccinated for rabies by a licensed veterinarian at least 1 month prior to the date of show. Proof of vaccination must be presented to the superintendent upon entry.

5. Cage birds that do not have their plumage may not be exhibited. Cage birds are to be brought to Youth Exhibit Building A at 10:30 a.m. on Sunday. Judging will begin at 11:30 a.m.

6. All other pets are to be brought to the Small Animal Building between 10:30 a.m. and 11:30 a.m. on Sunday of the fair. Judging will begin at 12:00 noon.

7. All pets must be claimed between 6:00 – 8:00 p.m. on Sunday.
