

DEPARTMENT 18 - CULTURAL ARTS (OPEN CLASS)

1. Entries must be brought in between 12 noon and 6:00 p.m. on Wednesday. All entries must be in place by 6:00 p.m.

2. Judging begins Thursday morning at 9:00 a.m. All are welcome to be present and ask questions of the judge after items are judged.

3. Maximum of **15** entries per exhibitor. Limited to **5** entries per exhibitor per class and only one entry per class/lot number.

4. If entered in the wrong category or if directions have not been followed, exhibit will be judged lower.

5. All articles must be initialed and dated with month and year (in ink where possible) and must have been made by the exhibitor. The Superintendent has the right to disqualify any entries not conforming to regulations.

6. All paintings and drawings must be matted (do not use good mats as they will be stapled) and sprayed if not framed. All artwork must be dry. Please be sure that your exhibit can be adequately hung. Put entry tag on top right corner of exhibit.

7. Items of questionable taste will not be accepted.
