5. Any exhibit that is designed to be hung up must be ready to be hung or will be dropped a placing
6. Exhibits will be judged on total presentation (i.e. picture has matting, stitchery is finished in a frame, made into a pillow, etc., articles are clean and unworn)
7. Entry tags must be securely attached or exhibit will be lowered one placing. All claim checks should have description of article written on them and removed for project pick up on Sunday.
8. All exhibits should be dated and signature or initials.
9. Individual conference judging will take place Wednesday, 12:00 to 6:00 p.m.
