

Department 111 – Domesticated Exotic Animals

EXOTIC GOATS

1. Refer to ATCP 160.08 for age divisions.
2. Check Wisconsin county fair animal health rules. Scrapie ear tag number must be printed on entry form. The farm Premise ID number must be printed on the entry form.
3. No intact male goats may be shown.
4. No horns permitted.
5. No more than **3** animals per exhibitor.
6. Judging will be Saturday following dairy goat judging at 10:00 a.m.

Class A – Exotic Goats

Pygmy, angora, cashmere, or any other exotic breed.

Class B –Fainting Goats

Premiums: \$5 - \$4 - \$3 - \$2

Lot Numbers - Class A & B

- 1 Doe kid (under 1 year)
- 2 Yearling doe (1 to 2 years, never freshened)
- 3 Mature doe (over 2 years that has freshened, including dry milkers)
- 4 Wether kid (under 1 year)
- 5 Wether (1 year and older)

Class C – Exotic Goat Showmanship

Danish judging. Exotic goat any age.

Premiums: \$3 - \$2.50 - \$2 - \$1.50

Lot Numbers

- 1 Member in grades 3-5
- 2 Member in grades 6 & up

Class D – Educational

No more than **1** exhibit per member. Posters must be 14" x 22". Attach entry tag to upper right corner. Maximum size on displays is 22" x 28". Exhibit must be brought to the Animal Science Department in Youth Exhibit Building B on entry day. Judging will take place Thursday.

Premiums: \$1.75 - \$1.50 - \$1.25 - \$1
